With the rapid change in music art, music philosophy is also evolving and deepening, thus injecting new theoretical vitality and practical guidance into music performing art (Dushniy, Boichuk, et al., 2022). As a core component of music art, the performing form and technique of music performance are naturally influenced by music philosophy. In the traditional concept, sound is only a carrier of music, but music philosophy gives sound a richer connotation. It believes that sound is not only the medium of music but also the carrier and conveyor of emotion; and vocal performance is not only the performance of art but also the mapping of social culture. This point of view puts forward higher requirements for music performing artists, who should not only focus on the beauty of sound, but also pay attention to the social and cultural background behind the music so that they can better understand the social information and emotion conveyed by the music, and ultimately convey the connotation of the music more accurately (Dushniy, Salii, et al., 2022; Kravchenko, 2022). Therefore, the study of music philosophy is of great significance in improving the level of music performance art and promoting the development of music art. As music performers, they should have a precise understanding and knowledge of the relevant theories of music philosophy, and at the same

time, they should know the important influence of music philosophy on music performance, so that they can reasonably apply music philosophy in music performance, constantly improve their performance skills, enrich their performance styles, and promote the innovation and development of music performance (Thompson et al., 2023). Philosophy is a social science based on the development of social material and spiritual life, which includes a large number of branches, and music philosophy is one of them. Philosophy of music plays a very important role in the process of music development and also has a theoretical and practical guidance value for music performance. Moreover, the objective and scientific study of music function has a very positive significance in promoting the orderly and healthy development of music performance. Philosophy of music is more inclined to elevate people's knowledge of music to a higher level so that people can form a kind of sensual understanding and awareness. With the deepening of the study of music philosophy, the holistic nature of music art has received more and more attention (Young, 2023). 


Figure 1: Analysis of General Trends




Figure 2: Scores of Music Majors in Positive Emotion Classical Music Experiment

The research of music philosophy in music performance involves many professional fields, including psychology, philosophy, sociology, etc. The main research contents include the relationship between reality and music, music content, music essence, etc. These studies are all related to epistemology, which is also the focus of music philosophy research. Psychology is mainly concerned with the research on the psychology of music appreciation, performance psychology, and creation psychology, which provides a rich

theoretical foundation for the essence of music; sociology is mainly concerned with the research on the significance of music in the era, social value, artistic function, and inheritance development, which determines the role and practical significance of music in the process of the development of the current society. Music performance mainly refers to the reproduction process and innovative activities of music works, which requires performers to interpret the works with their feelings and skills and convey the emotions and values of the works to the audience, triggering resonance (Li, 2022). It is not only a good medium for the public to watch the performance and the artists to create music, but also an essential step to carry out music activities. Therefore, in the process of theoretical investigation of music philosophy, the characteristics of music philosophy are identified, such as having a strong abstraction, theory, and so on. Music performance is the practical activity of real images. Music philosophy has a direct influence on the form and effect of the presentation of this activity, and music performance plays a decisive role in the scope and content of the study of music philosophy. In essence, music performance is the expression and transmission of the connotation of musical works, which requires performers to integrate their own emotions into the performance process and to have the correct aesthetic feeling and aesthetic understanding. 


Figure 3: Distribution of Different Scores in the Theoretical Knowledge Topic Test of Music Performance

emotions, and display the infinite charm of musical works (Karamanolis, 2023).

3.2 Philosophy of Music is Conducive to a Proper Understanding of Musical Performing Arts

A musical work consists of two parts, one is the creator's knowledge and understanding of the musical work, which mainly indicates the creator's intention and thoughts when creating music. It is produced in the creator's mind, without any concrete substance, but it is an indispensable part of the musical creation, and the success or failure of a musical work is also closely related to it. The other part is the score, which is used by the creator to record the musical inspiration during the creative process. The music form in the author's mind is recorded in the score and played by the performer. The existence of sheet music allows the creator to visualize his or her thoughts, and without sheet music, only the creator would be able to feel his or her music. However, sheet music is only a piece of paper, and its real form needs to be adapted and adjusted by the performer and the artist. Different people have different interpretations of the same piece of music, just like a thousand Hamlets in a thousand readers' minds (Liao, 2022). Therefore, music performers should have enough knowledge and understanding of the original works to better perform the real meaning of the works and show the beauty of music. The continuous development of music philosophy influences the development of music performance art, and people re-examine music performance art in the perception of music philosophy, and the two complement each other, not only in the form of artistic expression but also in the artistic creativity and connotation of music. The following table shows that education in the philosophy of music is taken very seriously in the UK from an early age.



In this environment, music performance is constantly developing in the direction of internationalization, and more and more countries and regions have formed a unified understanding of the development trend of music performance. Music performance is a way to express thoughts and emotions, and under the background of vigorously researching music philosophy, music performance has been widely recognized. With the deepening of the integration of music philosophy and music performance, music performance continues to develop to a higher level (Mohseni et al., 2023). In this process, promoting the effective innovation of music performance based on the perspective of music philosophy is an important issue for the majority of music performers to think about and study. The following two graphs, analysed through a study of listeners' emotions and level of understanding of the music, respectively, suggest that listeners are very demanding of music performers.






Figure 4: Speech Comprehension Performance Varies with the Listener's Musical Skill Level and Psychological Emotion Resources

4. PHILOSOPHY OF MUSIC IN PIANO PERFORMANCE

4.1 Enhance Deeper Knowledge of Piano Works

The integration of music philosophy into the process of piano performance can directly improve the piano player's knowledge of the piano music itself. In the past, during the piano performance, many listeners had difficulty understanding the meaning of piano music through the piano performance, and the main reason for this problem is that the performer's music philosophy literacy was not enough, and it was difficult to convey the actual emotion of the music to the audience through the performance. As a piano player, you need to realize that any piano performance is not only a performance of the melody, rhythm, and timbre of the piano piece but also an aesthetic enjoyment. Piano performance is not simply copying the notes in the piano sheet music, but conveying to the listener the emotions of the piano piece and the different emotions contained in the piano pieces completed by the composer in different situations and under different backgrounds, which not only allows the listener to communicate emotionally with the composer, but also lets the listener feel the development of different music in different eras and the different impacts of the era on people's lives through the analysis of piano pieces. This is a kind of social and cultural inheritance, but also a kind of communication through the space.

In the process of playing, the performer will also incorporate his own emotions due to his music aesthetics. When the three emotions come together, the piano music can play its aesthetic significance. To analyze the performance of piano music from the perspective of music aesthetics, it can be found that from the aesthetic point of view, the piano performance has more sensual factors, these sensual factors allow the performer to have different styles in the performance of a piano piece, even if it is the same piece of piano music by different players to bring the audience's feelings are different, which requires that all the players need to be in the performance of the piano piece of their understanding of the piano piece into the actual performance, utilizing their understanding of the piano piece, and then using the piano music to play the piano piece.

From table 2 it can be seen that the most critical stages for the influence of music philosophy on piano performers are at primary and secondary school, so the influence of music philosophy on piano performers is very important at all ages.

4.2 Helps Piano Players to Better Interpret Musical Works

A piece of music is created by the musician through the accumulation of experience, and it is full of the musician's own emotions. Therefore, when a piano player performs a piece of music, he or she must first strengthen the understanding of the piece of music, realize the emotions expressed in the piece of music, and at the same time, combine his or her playing skills to present the piece of music perfectly (Ansani et al., 2024). 


Figure 5: Fitting Effect of Stage Performance Effect and Actor Training
