She published more than 70 studies and articles in volumes and philosophical journals in Romania (Iași, București, Cluj-Napoca, Galați, Suceava) and outside (Bălți, Boston, Brasília, Chișinău, Dordrecht). She presented papers in Philosophy and Phenomenology Conferences and Congresses (Bălți, Boston, Brasília, Chișinău, Krakow, Puebla, Rome, Istanbul, Oxford). She graduated a probation in France (TEMPUS Programme 7471, 1995). She lectured, as Visiting Professor, at "Alecu Russo" University of Bălți (1998) and St.Joseph College, West Hartford, Connecticut (2005). She is member of the International Foundation "Stéphane Lupasco" and of the International Society of Phenomenology and Sciences of Life.
